- How to reserve one or more tables:
  - Print out, complete, and send in the Table Registration form with payment.
  - As in the past, requests for specific table positions will be done on a priority basis on our receipt of a completed application and advance payment.
  - If you plan to have a table, please complete an application beforehand to allow us to efficiently arrange the exhibition space to serve both dealers and the public.
  - In your application, make sure that your email and other contact information is correct so that we can confirm your registration and keep you updated about any last-minute issues.

#### **Driving Directions to Jewish Community Center**

- From the Northwest: Take Exit 256 from I-10. Follow Grant Road approximately five miles east to Alvernon. Turn left (north). Shortly past Ft. Lowell Road at the Dodge Road traffic light, turn right into the JCC parking lot.

- From the Southeast: Take Exit 265 from I-10. Follow Alvernon north approximately 7.5 miles. Shortly past Ft. Lowell Road at the Dodge Road traffic light, turn right into the JCC parking lot.
